1. MOPAC Quarterly Performance Report – Q1 2017/18

- 1.1. Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime (DMPC) and the Commissioner reviewed and discussed the Quarter 1 Performance Report, covering movements in crime data, public perception, MPS workforce data and MPS financial data.
- 1.2. Particular areas of discussion of the crime data included hate crime, sexual and domestic abuse, gun and knife crime, and moped enabled crime.
- 1.3. The discussion on workforce focused on vacancies, overtime and recruitment, and noted progress in reducing reliance on temporary staff. There was a discussion of the revenue, capital and reserve positions for the first quarter.
- 1.4. This is a new format for quarterly reporting, bringing together a range of performance and finance data into one place. The DMPC and Commissioner agreed to aim for publication in mid-September.
