1. MOPAC Quarterly Performance Report – Q2 2017/18

- 1.1. The Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime (DMPC) and the Commissioner reviewed and discussed the Quarter 2 Performance Report, which covered movements in crime data, public perception, milestones in the Met's transformation programme, MPS workforce data, MPS financial data, criminal justice data and MOPAC commissioning information.
- 1.2. Particular areas of discussion included:
 - the high harm crimes and how the Met focuses on the local priorities;
 - the victim satisfaction data and getting an understanding of what is behind the decrease in satisfaction, including how it compares to other forces and other public services;
 - the proportion of female police officers and the work being done to attract more female candidates;
 - the budget pressures.
- 1.3. The Quarter 2 report on the Met's progress against its business plan was also reviewed and discussed, with the DMPC noting that it is a very useful report.
