How long is the scheme?

One year. The coaching programme will **run from September 2019 to July 2020.**

To take part in the programme you must be:

Currently in a London school in a middle leadership role

- In a primary this could be:
 - Phase leader / key stage leader
 - Curriculum leader
 - Subject leader
 - Year group leader
 - SEND/Inclusion leader

- In a secondary this could be:
 - Head of year
 - Subject lead
 - Deputy Head of year (in large school)
 - Deputy subject lead (in large school)
 - SENCO
 - Or an equivalent middle leadership position

Responsible for at least one of the following:

- Whole school area
- Curriculum
- Line management
- Key area of school improvement

In middle leadership position for two years or more

Aspiring to senior leadership

Submit details of three referees who support your application, one of which must be your current line manager. These referees must submit their references before the deadline of 9am on Monday 1st July.
