### 1. Policing Performance Oversight Group

There was a discussion of the Policing Performance Oversight Group meeting that the Commissioner and Deputy Mayor had earlier attended, and the next steps towards addressing the issues identified by HMICFRS which prompted it to move the MPS into the engage phase of monitoring.

### 2. Improving Standards

There was a discussion of the progress the Commissioner had made towards improving standards in the MPS, as set out in his recent letter to the Mayor.

## 3. Live Facial Recognition

There was a discussion of the research the National Physical Laboratory had undertaken on the MPS's facial recognition technology, with a focus on bias and accuracy.

#### 4. Crown Prosecution Service

There was a discussion of the CPS's policy regarding putting charged people on remand, noting that it was having an impact on victim confidence.

# 5. London Policing Board

The Deputy Mayor updated the Commissioner on the progress City Hall was making towards establishing the London Policing Board, as recommended in Dame Louise Casey's review report.
