Guidance for providers

For learning aims to be Adult Education Budget-fundable by the GLA they must be listed on the [Find a Learning Aim Service](#) as valid for the MCA/GLA funding stream in the current academic year.

This form should be used to apply for any learning aim(s) that you wish to be added to the MCA/GLA funding stream for the 2023-24 academic year, making them eligible to be AEB funded by the GLA. Applications may only be made for qualifications which are not already part of an existing GLA qualification flexibility.
