Guidance for providers

The GLA SEND funding flexibility is outlined in the *GLA AEB Grant Funding and Performance Management Rules 2023-24*. The policy allows AEB funded providers to deliver learning that upskills teaching and learning support staff to deliver improved provision for adult learners with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

The SEND funding flexibility can only be used for:

- Staff employed within publicly funded adult and further education sectors in teaching or learning support roles.
- Upskilling existing staff in teaching or support roles to deliver specialist provision to SEND learners only.
- Staff who are London residents, in line with the delegation arrangements for AEB.

Only learning aims pre-approved by the GLA will be fundable within this flexibility.

Your application should demonstrate:

Details of the proposed learning aim(s) you wish to add to the list of eligible provision, including information on the qualification type and how the learning aim(s) will enable the upskilling of eligible teaching and learning support staff to deliver improved provision for learners with SEND.
