An extraordinary London CONTEST Board meeting took place on 16 November 2023. This extraordinary meeting was called for and chaired by the Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime the to seek reassurance that the multiagency response to the increasing terrorism risk, rising levels of antisemitism and anti-Muslim hate and continuing large-scale protests in London, triggered by the terrorist attacks in Israel and ensuing humanitarian crisis in Gaza, was adequately in hand.
