This data has been collated to compare the ethnicity of three different groups to support the ongoing analysis of the GPS tagging programme for knife crime:

1 - P-NOMS data - This is data extracted and published by MoJ that shows individuals released from relevant London prisons between 1 February 2019 and 26 February 2024 who were managed by London Probation when released. These data are based on Prison National Offender Management Information System (P-NOMIS) case management system broken down by ethnicity. For the purposes of these data, individuals convicted of knife crime offences are those who have been convicted of an offence involving a knife or a bladed/sharpened weapon where this is specified in statute as part of the wording for the offence.

- 2 Delius data This is data extracted and published by MoJ that shows individuals who have been released from prison who were managed by London Probation as at 30 June 2024 or individuals who are in prison as at 30 June 2024 and on release will be managed by London Probation. These data are based on National Delius (nDelius), the current probation case management system and are broken down by ethnicity. For the purposes of these data, individuals convicted of knife crime offences are those who have been convicted of an offence involving a knife or a bladed/sharpened weapon where this is specified in statute as part of the wording for the offence.
- 3 GPS cohort data This data is collated from the people included in the GPS tagging knife crime programme up to 18/11/24 broken down by recorded ethnicity
