Proposed Appointment to the Office of Chair of ReLondon

In accordance with Schedule 4A to the GLA Act 1999, I write to inform you of the Confirmation Hearings Committee's recommendation with regard to your proposed appointment of Mete Coban MBE to the office of Chair of ReLondon.

The Confirmation Hearings Committee put questions to Mete Coban MBE at its meeting on 9 December 2024 in relation to his proposed appointment. The Committee agreed via majority view not to obect to the proposed appointment of Mete Coban MBE to the office of Chair of ReLondon and to make further comment to you regarding the appointment.

In fulfilling this role, the Committee seeks assurance that:

- The candidate has sufficient regard to the urgency of the need to meet waste reduction and recycling targets arising in London.
- The candidate will be able to strike an appropriate balance between the role of Chair of ReLondon and the role of Deputy Mayor for Environment and Energy.

The Committee also notes that the proposed candidate brings only limited professional expertise, notwithstanding their work as Cabinet Member for Climate, Environment and Transport at the London Borough of Hackney. Therefore, the Committee seeks further assurance

that the candidate possesses the requisite credibility on key waste policy issues to provide effective leadership to the Board and to London more broadly.

In reaching this decision, the Committee's concerns centred around the candidate's CV and how it demonstrated or impacted on his ability to show leadership and act as a figurehead for ReLondon, particularly whether his record demonstrated regard to the urgency of the need to meet waste reduction targets arising in London and seeks further assurance on this matter.

A minority of the Committee felt the candidate's record of public facing leadership work was a credible way of fulfilling the leadership requirements of the role.

On behalf of the Confirmation Hearings Committee, I would like to welcome Mete Coban MBE to the role.
