Exactly how much additional monies have had to be paid to West Ham for the increase in security?

Please can you proved me with a the total cost of running the London stadium to the taxpayer in the last 12 months?

The GLA does not hold the information you requested. The following information was therefore provided to the GLA by the London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC):

No monies have been paid to West Ham for the increase in security.

LS185 operate the stadium on behalf E20, and an increased (following the Burnley match) security cost (including stewarding, security and police) of £55k plus vat has been forecast for the last five home matches of the season.

The total "net" cost of running the stadium for the last 12 months is forecast to be £21.8m.
