Subject: response to London Plan consultation

Hi,

I am writing about the draft London Plan consultation, which I am pleased recognises how important green spaces are. However, I want to ensure emphasis is placed to protect them e.g.

- Stronger enforcement to protect the Green Belt.
- Not allow the 'swap' of designated Metropolitan Open Land.
- Private and public gardens should be protected alongside other local green and open spaces.
- Policies are needed to improve the quality of green space by reducing noise, light and air pollution, increasing biodiversity, and by giving stronger protection to mature trees and hedgerows.
- Informal and formal outdoor sports facilities, including for ball sports, should be protected and enhanced.
- More quickly reduce the reliance on the private transport by reducing parking provision in new developments and promote sustainable transport modes.
- Excessive housing densities in new development should be resisted to protect the local character of London's neighbourhoods.
