The current plans will result in a substantial and devastating change to London and to the outer boroughs. London should not be trying to build its way out of a housing crisis, this will only encourage ever more people to come to London and make London a city like Mexico which is huge but failing. There needs to be a greater focus in preventing ever more people arriving in London from overseas and putting strain on the community, the infrastructure and the housing.

I recognise that the Mayor is unlikely to adopt a strategy that will result in fewer people arriving in London as these new arrivals tend to vote Labour and the underlying agenda seems to be political rather than what is best for London.
