On the 1st March 2018 I tried to register online using [REDACTED]

I did not receive a welcome message or further instructions after 10 hours and concluded that there was something wrong with the registration system.

Policy H1

I oppose the proposed 60% increase in Havering's Housing targets.

Havering has a Local Plan which has been under development for over 3 years and will be examined this summer 2018.

The current existing further additions to the London Plan annual housing target is 1,170.
The new Local plan annual housing target is 1,366.

The new Local Plan target is achievable using brownfield land and no Green Belt land will be lost in Havering.

The London Plan target is 1,875 a 60% increase.
According to Havering planners it is not possible to achieve the London Plan target unless Green Belt land is de-designated.

To the average resident in Havering there has been no explanation from the mayor where he got this figure from and which land is available to build the new target 1,875 per annum.

The Local Plan cannot succeed in the public examination in the summer of 2018 if it does not comply with the mayor's emerging London Plan.

To the layman in Havering the mayor is not listening to Havering planners and what housing target is achievable without building on the Green Belt.

The mayor must explain in detail where he intends to build his additional houses otherwise he will have no credibility in the eyes of Borough residents.

Before changing housing targets the mayor should engage with stakeholders and explain where the land for new targets is coming from.
