I am writing to object to the Mayor's draft London Plan which I have just seen published on [London.Gov.UK](https://www.london.gov.uk).

My main point of objections are:

1 - Presumption in favor of developers. Developers are not the friends of communities, they are only friends to themselves and their profits. Things are already massively skewed in their favour, and removing further checks will be disastrous.

2 - Metropolitan Open Land. Our open spaces are precious and must be protected. This plan weakens this protection and therefore must be opposed

3 - Conservation Areas. These are part of what makes London special, and gives normal, common people the chance to live somewhere beautiful. This plan weakens protection and allows developers to do what they want, it's already hard enough to stop them destroying beautiful things

I trust this ill-conceived plan will be revisited. Whilst I appreciate the need for further housing this is not the way to do it.
