I understand the London Mayor, Sadiq Khan, has published his draft London Plan which proposes to deliver thousands of new houses. That ambition is great, we all know that more affordable housing is needed in London, but the way he wants to do it is not, as he expects outer London boroughs like Sutton to deliver most of this housing. This will mean turning suburbs into intensively developed estates.

The plan proposes that Sutton more than doubles its number of planned new homes from 427 to 939 per annum, and in order to deliver this level of housing, back garden developments and infilling should be allowed. Should this plan go ahead it would mean an urbanisation of my borough, with Wallington South, and our status as an Area of Special Local Character will be at risk.

I strongly object to this urbanisation.
