## Dear Sir or Madam

Firstly, I'd like to admit I haven't had time to read most of the plan.

I wanted to share with you the 3 most important issues for me in London:

- 1- Better pedestrian and cycling provision. And more disincentives for private car drivers. Including: creating more pedestrianised areas for example, I'm in favour of pedestrianizing Oxford St, Regent St, the whole of Soho, and the Inner and Outer Circles around Regents Park (usual exemptions for emergency vehicles and deliveries); more and wider cycle superhighways; more 20mph speed limits; stronger enforcement of speed limits; extending the congestion charging zone; increasing the daily fee for the congestion charging zone; reducing the amount of car parking places, and converting them to wider pavements or cycle parking places.
- 2- Cleaner air
  Bringing in lower limits on car emissions. Higher penalties for those which breach the limits.
- 3- More affordable housing
  The only sustainable solution I see to this is increasing supply by building more housing. This must require
  some rollback of the green belt legislation, as well as denser housing in certain areas for example Canary
  Wharf, Vauxhall.
