The process of becoming a member of any profession begins many years before exams are undertaken. Whether it's your first encounter as a young person or taking up a leadership role, each career stage presents opportunities for people to be inspired and motivated, or to be discouraged and frustrated. The Supporting Diversity Handbook is a tool for advocacy, communication, and action on the barriers to equality, diversity and inclusion in the built environment sector. It proposes sector-wide actions as well as making practical recommendations at each career stage to ensure that the profession is accessing and enabling the best talent to thrive.
