Strategic Policy 4 Thriving Communities

Sets out policy to:

- promote lifetime neighbourhoods, social cohesion and the integration of new and existing communities through protecting existing and providing new homes
- deliver a minimum of 22,350 new homes
- deliver the overarching 50% affordable housing target



Development Management Housing Policies

Sets out different policies as follows:

- **H1** deliver a minimum of 22,350 new homes
- **H2** deliver an overarching target for 50% affordable housing comprising 30% as London Affordable Rent and 70% as a range of Intermediate housing
- H3 deliver a mix of housing types and sizes, including 25% as family housing
- H4 deliver family housing to ensure it is suitable for families with children
- **H5** resist the loss of existing housing, manage conversions and bring vacant homes into use
- H6 manage the delivery of purpose built Private Rented Sector housing to deliver affordable housing, manage its long-term use and secure appropriate management arrangements
- **H7** manage purpose built shared housing and existing housing in multiple occupation
- **H8** protect the existing Bashley Road Gypsy and Travellers Site and give careful consideration to the future housing needs of gypsies and travellers
- **H9** support the delivery of specialist housing
- H10 deliver student accommodation to create sustainable communities
