

London Curriculum Family Explorer Trail Photo Competition

Privacy statement

The family / individual /person is responsible for and must obtain any necessary parental/guardian consents and must provide any necessary notices required in connection with the disclosure and use of personal information of the entrants as described in these terms and conditions.

The Greater London Authority (GLA), its subsidiaries and service providers, will use your personal information for the purposes of administering this competition, informing you if you have won and if so, issuing your prize. Your personal information will be properly safeguarded and processed in accordance with the requirements of the Data Protection Act 1998.

Terms and conditions

1. The Promoter of the London Curriculum Family Explorer Trail photo competition prize draw is the Greater London Authority of City Hall, The Queen's Walk, More London, London, SE1 2AA.
2. Entry is only open to UK residents excluding employees of [the Greater London Authority, Transport for London, London Legacy Development Corporation, the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime, the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority] or any of their subsidiaries advisers, agents and/or anyone connected with the organisation of this promotion. If you are using your work computer you may need to obtain your employer's permission prior to entering.
3. A parent or carer must enter a child/group/family by posting a photo using the following hashtag on social media – **#LondonIsOpen** for Summer. Parents and carers must have the necessary parental/guardian permission before doing so. Any entry made not using the official hashtag or which is incomplete, illegible, defaced or a copy of an official image will be rejected.
4. Photos must be in the spirit of the Mayor's London Curriculum programme, which turns London into a classroom. It puts the city at the heart of teaching in London's primary and secondary schools and helps children engage with their school subjects and their heritage as young Londoners.
5. The Competition begins at 12pm on Tuesday 1 August 2017 ("the Opening Date") and runs until 12pm on 30 September 2017 ("the Closing Date"). Entries to the Competition must be made via social media no later than 12pm on 30 September.
6. Entries are limited to one per family/social media account.
7. Each week, on a Friday, a winner will be selected.
8. The winning photograph will be the entrants who, in the sole opinion of the judges, captures the spirit of the London Curriculum in the most original way.

9. The prizes for the Competition are a selection of small gifts, such as books, T-Shirts etc.
10. Winning entrants will be notified via social media using the contact information provided no later than one week after submitting a photo. If the GLA is unable to contact any winner, or if any prize is not claimed within 10 days of being notified the winner will be deemed to have forfeited their prize. In such instances, we will choose a new winner for that prize.
11. Prize winners will need to claim their prize by 13 October 2017.
12. Prizes will be sent to winners at the address provided by 27 October 2017.
13. Winners may be required to take part in promotional activities.
14. The judges' decision is final and binding in all matters and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. The Promoter reserves the right to substitute any prizes with a prize of equivalent or higher value in the event of circumstances outside of its control. Prizes are non-transferable. There is no cash alternative to prizes.
16. Entry into the Competition implies acceptance of these terms and conditions. The Greater London Authority reserves the right to refuse to award prizes to anyone found to be in breach of these terms and conditions.
17. The GLA reserves the right to cancel the competition at any stage if it considers such action necessary, or for reasons beyond the GLA's reasonable control, and the GLA will have no liability to the entrants in respect of any such cancellation.
