Mayor, Sadiq Khan, has been clear that EU citizens living in London belong and are welcome here. To help them find out what Brexit means for them and how they can apply for Settled Status he has set up a new information hub.

What does Brexit mean for your status?

If you're a European living here under Freedom of Movement, your residence status will change when the UK leaves the EU. If you want to continue to live and work in the UK, you must apply for a new residence status – Settled Status. If you and your family members are citizens from any of the 27 EU states (EU27) and live in the UK, you will all have to apply. This includes Third Country nationals - whose immigration status is dependent on an EU27 family member.

How can you apply for settled status?

Government has said the Settled Status scheme will open fully in March 2019 and you must apply by 30 June 2021. Each application will cost £65 for those aged 16 and over, and £32.50 for those under 16. You can apply online.
