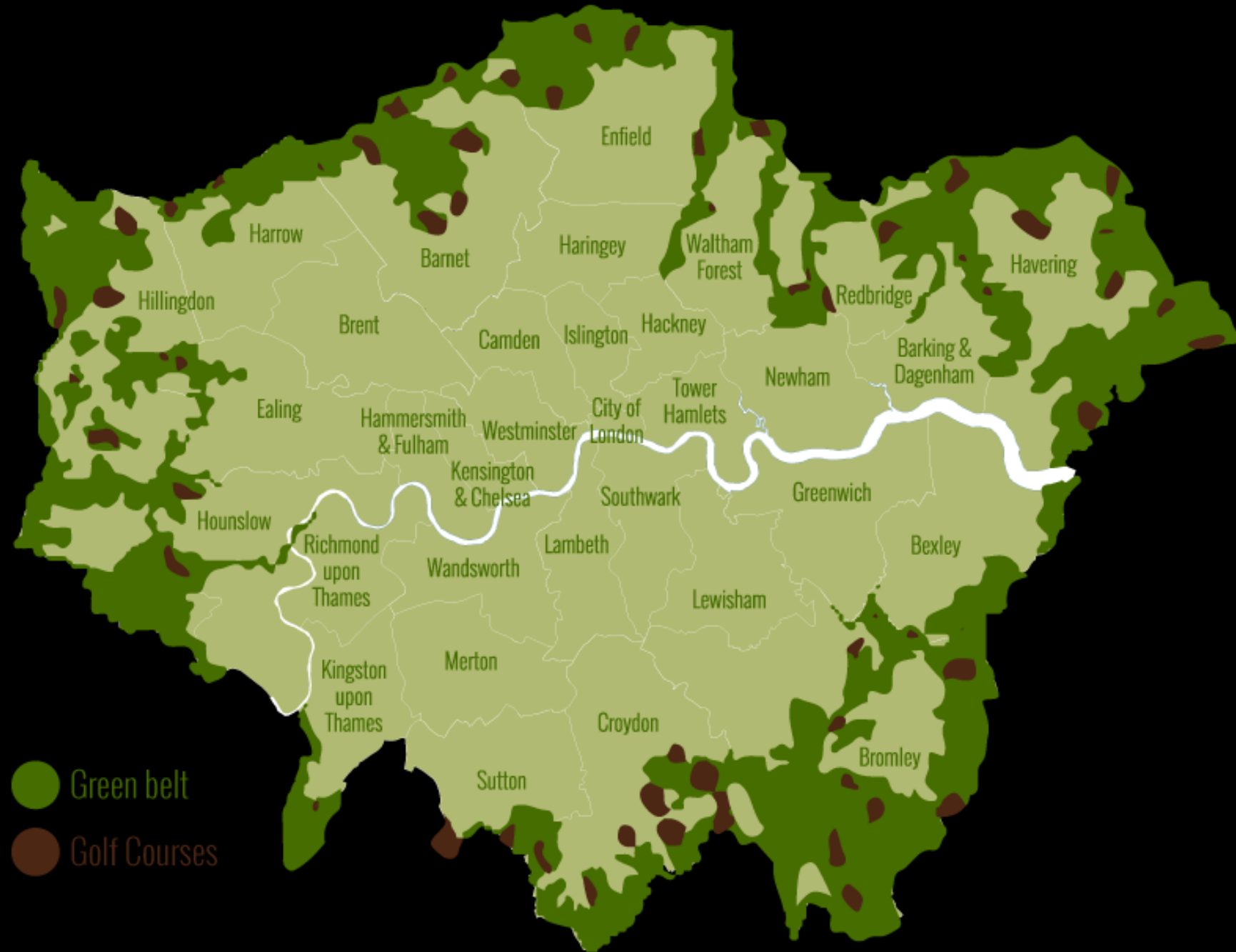
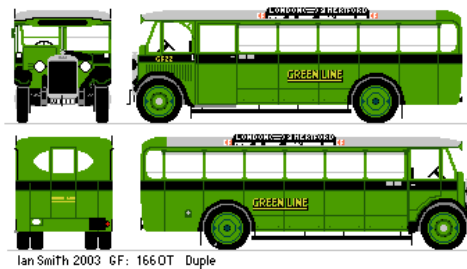

OUT by Green Line Coach [F]
from Marble Arch (Park Lane) to Botley Hill
(Cross Roads). Daily 2/9 return. Via Hyde
Park Corner, Victoria (Eccleston Bridge),
Brixton, Streatham, Croydon

RAMBLE 8 miles: along the ridge of
the North Downs, thence by South Hawke
and Robins Wood to Oxted, and so by
field-path to Godstone

HOME by Green Line Coach [HI H2]
Use the return half of your ticket this way
back to London. From Godstone Green
(Hare & Hounds) to Marble Arch, via Brixton,
Victoria (Eccleston Bridge), Hyde Park Corner
