### **Parade Timings:**

St Patrick's Day Parade: 12.00pm – 2.30pm (latest)

Form up area: Piccadilly Eastbound from Hyde Park Corner to Half Moon

Street (nearest tube Green Park/Hyde Park Corner)

Entry for floats: 9:30 - 10:30am

\*(no later or you will lose your park-up slot and be put at the end of the parade, separated

from any walking group contingent)

Walkers' Registration: 10:30 – 11:15am

Parade Order Call: 11:30

Move off: 12.00pm prompt

Dispersal: 1pm – 2.30pm (depending on parade section)

#### **Float Construction:**

- All floats must be ready for a safety inspection prior to the event. Any floats that fail
  inspection or do not arrive on time will not be permitted in the procession.
- Any generators must be DIESEL, secured away from reach of children, securely fastened to the float, earthed, and RCD protected.
- No naked flames will be allowed on the vehicle.
- Vehicles and drivers must be fully insured. Drivers will be expected to show their driving license and proof of insurance during inspection.
- All electrical equipment is required to have valid PAT certification. Any generators
  privately hired are required to produce a valid electrical safety certificate. Failure to
  do so could mean exclusion from the parade. These documents must be made
  available at the safety inspection.
- If participants are riding on the floats, safety railings must be fitted to trucks that meet the satisfaction of the Event Safety Advisor.
- All decoration and items to be securely fixed.
- No sharp objects should protrude from the sides.
- Materials and fabrics should be fire-proofed and/or have the relevant fire certification.
- CO2 or Powder fire extinguishers need to be located on each float.
