Westminster to next meeting The publication of a **Pier Strategy** was agreed as a priority for the group however it was agreed that consideration of the need for a pier should be determined through a Pier Action Plan which the group would create and own. Regarding expansion of piers to the east it was agreed that **new piers and** river services in East London could include a need to engage Kent and Essex at some stage. With regard the priority: to promote the river DP proposed that the group should consider opportunities to help increase patronage in 2018 and reach the MTS target. The groups discussed the importance of promoting the activation events already planned, including: the Illuminated Bridges project; more from Totally Thames festival; more links with the night time economy and the 100th anniversary of WW1.
