### WHAT'S NEW?

A new framework of 16 specialist, fully OJEU compliant Service Providers is now in place to procure a range of energy conservation measures, as well as energy generation works to allow for substantial guaranteed energy savings and reduced carbon emissions.

Turner & Townsend was re-appointed to act as the Programme Delivery Unit (PDU) and provide free of charge support to public sector organisations within London. The funding of the PDU's services has been secured from the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and the GLA.

## PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

### West London Alliance – LB Hounslow

Supported by the RE:FIT programme, LB of Hounslow has installed over 6,000 solar panels on the rooftop of the Western International Market (WIM), and is the first authority to adopt battery storage to maximise power use on site and minimise export to the national grid. With a total of 6,069 panels, the £2m investment by the council will generate approximately half of the market site's required electricity (3.5MW), the equivalent of powering 1,750 homes.
