The West London Alliance (WLA) is a partnership of six west London councils - Barnet, Brent, Ealing, Harrow, Hillingdon and Hounslow. The WLA has been working together to achieve shared goals, including enhanced social, economic and environmental position of west London. It signed up to RE:FIT in summer 2013 and actively developed a collaborative project, initially involving five of the six councils as well as three neighbouring authorities (Westminster City Council, London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham and the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea). The energy conservation measures installed across WLA buildings include:

- lighting and controls upgrade
- loft and cavity walls insulation
- solar photovoltaic systems
