




Talk London is an online community established to involve Londoners in the development of policy and programmes at City Hall.



Q.1 – Have you ever <u>booked</u> the following through a short-term letting site such as Airbnb, Booking.com or SpareRoom?







Q.2 – You said you have booked a whole property through a short-letting site. Where was this? Please tick all that apply.



Q.3 – You said you have booked a private room through a short-letting site. Where was this? Please tick all that apply.


Q.4 – Have you ever <u>let out</u> the following through a short-term letting site such as Airbnb, Booking.com or SpareRoom?







Q.5 – You said you have let out your whole home through a short-letting site. Where was this? Please tick all that apply.

Q.7 – Over the past year, have you noticed any properties in your local area being let out through short-term letting sites such as Airbnb, Booking.com or SpareRoom?






Q.9 – Generally speaking, do you think short-term letting is good or bad for London, or does it make no real difference?

Q.10 – And do you think short-term letting is or is not acceptable in the following situations?








