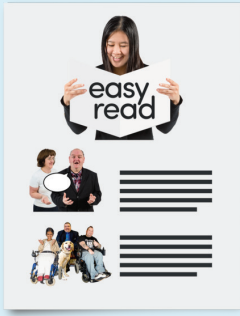

Easy read form



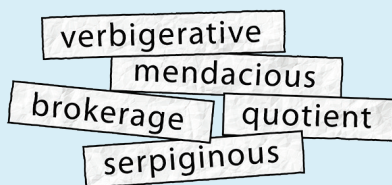
This is an Easy Read version of some information. It has words and pictures.

Who we are



We are **Talk London**.
We work for the **Mayor of London**.



We are an **online community** who want to know what you think about problems that matter to you.



An **online community** is a safe space online where people talk and share what they think.



We are working with **Greater London Councils** to make London a better place to live and work.



We know that it can be hard for people in London to get the right help to find a job.



To make this better, we made a plan called the **Inclusive Talent Strategy** or the **ITS** for short.



This booklet tells you about our **ITS** and some of our ideas to give you our help.



We have written some questions for you to answer to tell us what you think. This is called a **form**.



We will use what you tell us to make our **ITS** better.

Our Inclusive Talent Strategy



Lots of people have told us it is hard to get help to find a job and learn new skills.



They said it is hard to know

- what help there is
- where the help is
- who to talk to.



This means that lots of people are **unemployed** which means they do not have a job.



Our ITS will make it easier for you to

- find a job
- learn new skills
- have a **career**.



A **career** is the type of work you decide to do for a long time.



Our ITS will also make the **economy** better.



The **economy** means how money is made and spent in the UK.



When the economy is better

- it can be easier to get a job
- people might get paid more
- things might cost less money.

We want to put all the help in 1 place to make it easier for you find and use.

We have 2 ideas about how we could do this.

Idea 1



Idea 1 is to make an **online platform**.



An **online platform** is a website or phone app where people can talk, learn and share information.



The online platform could

- tell you about jobs
- give you training
- give you **careers guidance**.



Careers guidance is help to find a job you want to do for a long time, and plan your future.

Idea 2



Idea 2 is to have more **joined up** in person help.



Joined up means that different teams and organisations work together to give better help.



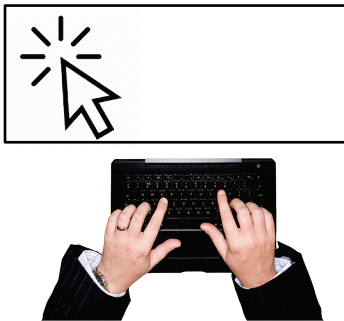
The in person help could

Summary	How could we make it easier for Londoners to find the right support for jobs, training, or careers?

Many Londoners have told us it's hard to know where to look for help with jobs, skills and careers. Support is often found in different places, and it's not always clear what's available or where to go.

A key part of the Inclusive Talent Strategy will be to make sure that Londoners can get into vital jobs that will help London's economy grow.

To make this simpler for Londoners, City Hall is exploring new ways to bring support together. That way, everyone can access the help they need, whether online or in-person.

This could include:

- An **online platform** that acts as a 'one stop shop' to job vacancies, training, and career guidance across London.
- More **joined-up in-person support**, where help with work, learning and advice is available whenever you first seek it.
